Thou shalt not kill

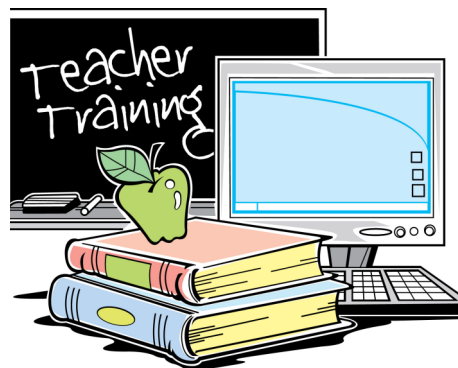
VII
